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# Why we reject 2/3 Isaiah's

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**Unified testimony from ancient world of single authorship**

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**Jn 12:39-41 For this reason they could not believe, because, as Isaiah says elsewhere: "He has blinded their eyes and deadened their hearts, so they can neither see with their eyes, nor understand with their hearts, nor turn—and I would heal them."**

**Isaiah said this because he saw Jesus' glory and spoke about him.**
