- 5. Emergence of Reconstituted Roman Empire Dan 2, 7, Rev. 13


The 10 Major Markers of the First 3 1/2 Years

- 10. First thrust of Armageddon Ezek 38-39

- 1. Gog and Magog invasion
- 2. Martyrdom of 144,000 Jewish evangelist
- 3. Martyrdom of 2 witnesses
- 4. Casting out of Satan from heaven
- 5. AntiChrist fully revealed

- Lk 10:18 And He said to them, "I was watching Satan fall from heaven like lightning."
- Rev 9:1 Then the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star from heaven which had fallen to the earth; and the key of the bottomless pit was given to him.

Lucifer

- Isa 14
- Rev 20:2,3 And he laid hold of the dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; and he threw him into the abyss, and shut it and sealed it over him, so that he would not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were completed; after these things he must be released for a short time.
- Rev 20:7 When the thousand years are completed, Satan will be released from his prison, and will come out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth
- Rev 20:10 And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

The "Signs"

• John 2:11 This beginning of His signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory, and His disciples believed in Him.

Sign One - The Woman/Child

• Gen 37:9,10 Soon Joseph had another dream, and again he told his brothers about it. "Listen, I have had another dream," he said. "The sun, moon, and eleven stars bowed low before me!" This time he told the dream to his father as well as to his brothers, but his father scolded him. "What kind of dream is that?" he asked. "Will your mother and I and your brothers actually come and bow to the ground before you?"

Sign One - The Woman/Child

• Rom 9:4,5 They are the people of Israel, chosen to be God's adopted children. God revealed his glory to them. He made covenants with them and gave them his law. He gave them the privilege of worshiping him and receiving his wonderful promises. Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob are their ancestors, and Christ himself was an Israelite as far as his human nature is concerned. And he is God, the one who rules over everything and is worthy of eternal praise! Amen.

- Heb 2:14 Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil
- 1Jn 3:8 The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil.

• Structure: Eph 6:12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.

Sign Two - The Dragon

- 2Tim 2:26 and they may come to their senses and escape from the snare of the devil, having been held captive by him to do his will.
- 2Cor 4:4 in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.
- 2Cor 11:3 But I am afraid that, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, your minds will be led astray from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ.
